Guest Speakers

Jim Lynam owns a long and storied basketball history. A three-year starter at Saint Joseph's University (1960-63), Lynam scored 1,012 career points and helped the Hawks make three-straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including the 1961 NCAA Final Four. Lynam amassed an impressive 158-118 record in 10 college seasons at Fairfield University (1968-70), American University (1973-78) and Saint Joseph's University (1978-81). After several successful head-coaching stints at the collegiate level, Lynam made the jump to the NBA, which included 10 seasons as a head coach with three different teams – San Diego/ L.A. Clippers (1983-85), Philadelphia 76ers (1987-92) and Washington Bullets (1995-97 – Lynam has compiled a 328-392 career record.

Mark Turgeon will begin his third season as the head coach of the University of Maryland Terrapins in 2013-14. Last season, he led the Terps to a 25-win season and an appearance in the NIT semifinals, and this past summer, he saw sophomore Alex Len drafted by Phoenix with the fifth pick in the 2013 NBA Draft. Turgeon is 292-187 in his 16th season overall as a head coach, with stops at Wichita State, Jacksonville State and Texas A&M. He also spent a season as an assistant coach under Larry Brown with the Philadelphia 76ers in 1997-98.

In 2013-14, **Dave Paulsen** will begin his sixth season as the head coach of Bucknell University. A two-time National Coach of the Year and 2013 NABC Co-District 13 Coach of the Year, Paulsen has amassed a 99-65 record at Bucknell with three-straight outright Patriot League season titles, two Patriot League Tournament titles, two NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament appearances and a took a trip to the second round of the NIT in 2012. This past season, the Bison went 28-6 - a school record. Paulsen serves on the NCAA Division I Regional Advisory Committee and is a member of the NABC Congress.

Monté Ross, the University of Delaware's 23rd head coach, begins his eighth season at the helm of the Blue Hens in 2013-14. Ross led his 2012-13 team to a second place finish in the Colonial Athletic Association and a 19-14 overall mark. Prior to Delaware, Ross was an assistant coach at Lehigh, Drexel and Saint Joseph's. During that time, Ross helped his teams to nine winning seasons, seven 20+ win records, six NCAA Tournament appearances and five conference championships.
